
- Looking at February temperature.

- International: China cold, Argentina heat, Europe is mild but will turn cold. Panama stays dry.






WARM CLIMATE INFLUENCES AS FEBRUARY ARRIVES

Cold stratosphere causes a warm North America climate (note new warming).









HEATING DEGREE DAY FORECASTS REFLECT THE WARMTH

After a moderate cold spike in January, warmer than 10-year in FEB.









TROUBLE IS BREWING...COLDER LATER FEBRUARY

Same in Europe...Shifting colder.









UPPER AIR PATTERN IN 4 WEEKS

Hot start to FEB biases the monthly forecast warmer than normal.









ATMOSPHERIC RIVER

ECM Week-2 Ahead: Plenty of rain (ans snow) West to North-central U.S.









EXISTING DROUGHT FADING IN EL NINO RAINS

The TUE-THU 72-hour precipitation amount forecast.









UNITED STATES SPRING 2024 OUTLOOK

Could be stormier than indicated (as El Nino weakens).









UNITED STATES SUMMER 2024 CLIMATE

Texas dryness to return during summer!









